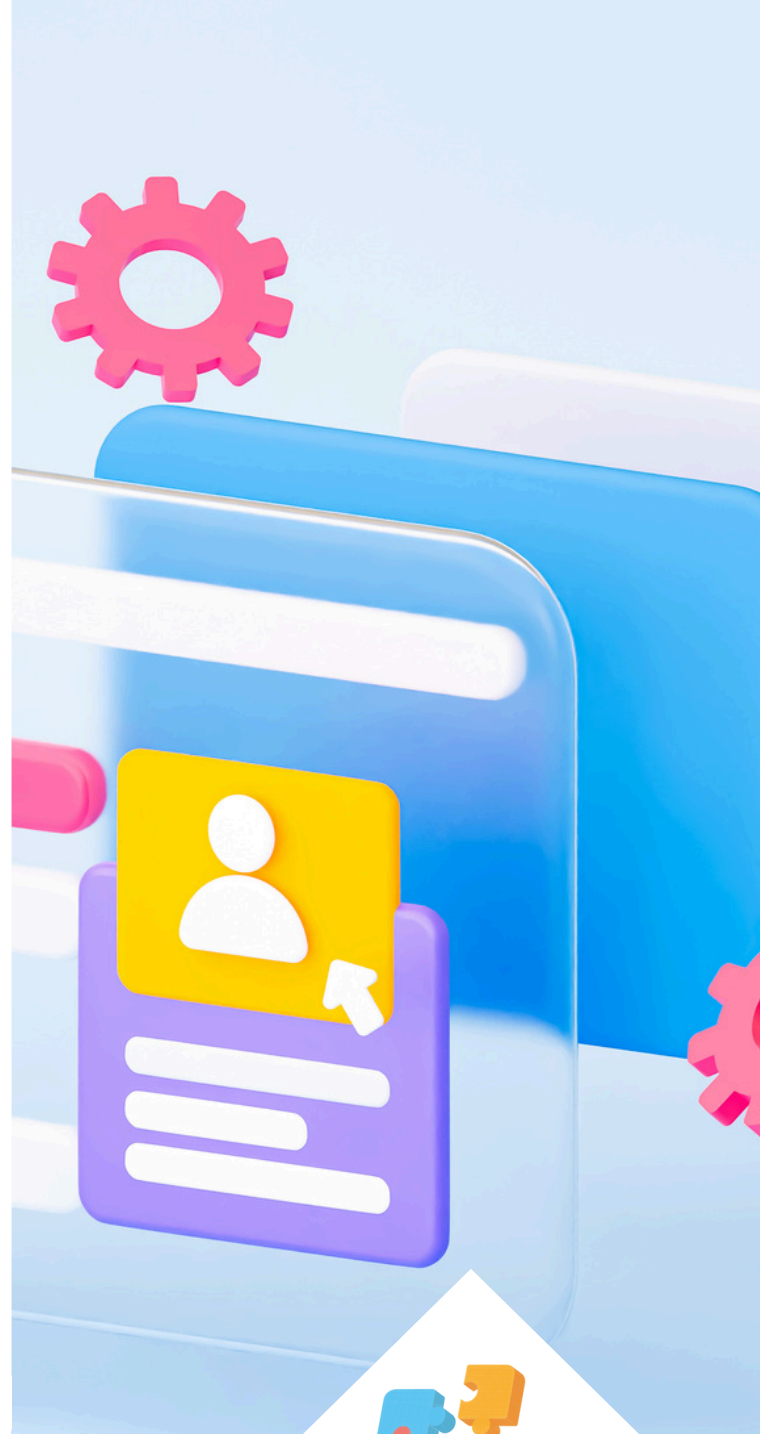

ABOUT CYPRUS

Cyprus, the third largest island in the Eastern Mediterranean, is a destination rich in history, culture, and natural beauty. Strategically located at the crossroads of Europe, Asia, and Africa, the island covers 9,251 square kilometers and offers a remarkable variety of landscapes, from golden beaches and crystal-clear waters to rugged mountains and traditional villages.

The Republic of Cyprus is home to approximately 923,000 people, the majority of whom are Greek Cypriots, and is known for its warm hospitality and strong cultural traditions. A member of the European Union since 2004, Cyprus adopted the euro as its official currency in 2008. Today, the island is a vibrant hub for tourism, business, and cultural exchange, welcoming visitors with its unique blend of ancient heritage and modern lifestyle.



ABOUT LARNACA

Larnaca is a coastal city in Cyprus that combines a long history with a laid-back, everyday rhythm of life. It is one of the island's oldest settlements, featuring ancient sites, traditional neighborhoods, and a historic town center alongside modern infrastructure. The city is known for its palm-lined seafront, nearby salt lake with seasonal flamingos, and its role as an important transport and commercial hub, as it is home to Cyprus's main international airport.

CYPRUS AIRPORTS

Legal Ports of Entry:

Cyprus is served by two international airports:

- **Larnaca International Airport (LCA)**
- **Paphos International Airport (PFO)**

These airports connect the island to destinations across Europe, the Middle East, and beyond, with numerous airlines operating regular scheduled and seasonal flights.

Travelers are encouraged to use the internationally recognized airports of Larnaca (LCA) and Paphos (PFO) when entering the Republic of Cyprus. Additional official guidance and up-to-date information can be found on the website of the [Cyprus Ministry of Foreign Affairs](#).

Both airports are well linked to major cities through Cyprus's extensive highway network, making travel to and from each airport fast and convenient.

Most major airlines' scheduled flight operations are served by Larnaca International Airport, while Paphos International Airport mostly serves low-cost and charter flights.

Important Note: Visitors are advised that Ercan Airport (ECN) is located in the northern part of Cyprus, an area that is not under the effective control of the Republic of Cyprus. According to the laws of the Republic of Cyprus, entry into the country via Ercan Airport is not recognized as a legal point of entry.

HOW TO GET FROM THE AIRPORTS TO THE VENUE

Traveling from Larnaca or Paphos International Airport to the venue is straightforward, with both economical public transport options and comfortable private transfers available. Below are the two main ways to reach the venue, depending on your preference for convenience and budget.

Option 1: Taxi

You can take a taxi directly from the airport to the venue. Taxis are available outside the arrivals hall at any time and offer door-to-door service.

Approximate travel times:

- From Larnaca Airport: around 15 minutes
- From Paphos Airport: around 90 minutes

Approximate taxi fares to Larnaca (Venue):

- €35 - €50 from Larnaca Airport (depending on time)
- €150–€190 from Paphos Airport (depending on time)

Option 2:

Public Transportation - From Larnaca Airport

To use the public transportation from Larnaca Airport, exit the arrivals terminal and follow the signs to the public bus stop located just outside the building.

Several city buses (such as routes **407, 425, 429, 430, 431, and 432**) run from the airport to Larnaca city center, including stops near the Finikoudes Promenade (city center) and the central bus station.

Tickets are purchased **directly from the driver in cash**, and the journey typically takes **20–30 minutes**, depending on traffic. Buses run regularly during the day, making this the most convenient and affordable public transport option into the city.

Public Transportation - From Paphos Airport

The most convenient public transportation from **Paphos International Airport** to Larnaca city is the Kapnos Airport Shuttle. Pre-booking is not required.

Shuttles depart directly from outside the arrivals area and travel non-stop to Larnaca city (Finikoudes area). The journey typically takes **2 hours**.

VISA INFORMATION

Most travellers from European Union (EU) countries — and from EFTA countries (Switzerland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway) — can enter Cyprus without a visa, using a valid passport or national ID card with photo.

For many non-EU citizens, a valid multiple-entry Schengen-area short-stay visa (Category C) or a residence permit issued by an EU/Schengen member state (or by certain other countries — e.g. recently joined members) allows entry to Cyprus for a stay up to 90 days within any 180-day period.

The above mentioned **DO NOT** apply to holders of Turkish or Azerbaijani passports. If you hold a passport from either country, please click [here](#) for further information on how to apply for a Cyprus visa.

A list of countries requiring a Visa to enter Cyprus can be found on the webpage: www.mfa.gov.cy. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs is the Ministry in charge of consular and entry requirement matters.

GETTING AROUND

Getting around in Cyprus is easy and flexible thanks to several transport options.

TAKE A TAXI

Taxis are widely available and offer a convenient mode of transport across the island. Cyprus has many taxi companies operating in all cities, making it easy to find a ride at any time of day.

In addition to traditional taxi services, the Bolt app is also available in Cyprus, providing guests with a quick and reliable way to book a taxi directly from their phone.

RENT A CAR

For greater independence, some people choose to rent a car, roads are well-maintained, and driving is on the left side of the road.

USE PUBLIC BUSES

Public buses connect major cities such as Nicosia, Limassol, Larnaca, Paphos, and Ayia Napa, with frequent routes and affordable fares.

Kapnos Airport Shuttle: Frequent transfers from Larnaca and Paphos Airports to Larnaca. Note that the shuttle drops passengers at the Kapnos station in Larnaca, from where a taxi is required to reach your final destination.

Cyprus By Bus: A comprehensive platform with route details, timetables, fares, and maps.

Intercity Buses: Information on schedules and services between major towns.

For the most up to date transport details and schedules, travellers should refer to the Ministry of Transport, Communications and Works' official website. It is advisable to check with relevant transport providers for the latest information before travelling.

WALKING & CYCLING

Walking and cycling are pleasant and practical ways to move around many parts of Cyprus. The island offers a variety of pedestrian-friendly routes and cycling paths, allowing visitors to enjoy the surroundings at a relaxed pace. Whether for short trips or leisurely exploration, both walking and cycling provide an easy and environmentally friendly way to get around.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DRIVING

Traffic drives on the left side of the road, follow local regulations.

ELECTRICITY

Plug type G (three rectangular pins). Voltage 230V / 50Hz.

Many hotels offer Universal Plugs and USB chargers in their rooms. Some hotels offer adapters at the reception (with deposit). Please make sure to have an adapter ready though, if you might need to charge your device during the conference.

CURRENCY

The official currency is the Euro (€)

LANGUAGE

Official language: Greek. English is widely spoken.

TIME ZONE

Time in Cyprus is given by Eastern European Time (EET) (UTC+02:00) or Eastern European Summer Time (EEST) (UTC+03:00) during the summer

COMMUNICATIONS

Country code: +357
Main landline codes: 22 (Nicosia), 25 (Limassol), 26 (Paphos), 24 (Larnaca).

WEATHER

Cyprus has a typical Mediterranean climate. Summers (June–September) are hot, and sunny, with temperatures often between 30–38°C. Winters (December–February) are mild, with temperatures around 14–18°C and occasional rain, while the mountains may see some snow.
